## Introduction

Thank you for your interest in Tampa Housing Authority's (THA) EFFORTS (Education Funding For Our Residents to Succeed) Scholarship Program. The EFFORTS Scholarship Program was established in 2022 as a method to continue to support our youth located in Public Housing, RAD, and Section 8 Housing.

The goal of the EFFORTS Scholarship Program is to encourage our young adults to pursue their educational dreams. The program is directed to high school seniors and undergraduate freshman students enrolled in the semester following the scholarship award. These students must exemplify leadership accomplishments, as well as have a high academic standing. The \$3,000 scholarship award will be provided to seven (7) undergraduate students based on a competition that will be administered by THA's Program and Property Services Department (PPS).

## Purpose

The purposes of the THA EFFORTS Scholarship Program are:

- To further assist the residents that Tampa Housing Authority serves.
- To encourage our young adults to advance their education and explore their career interests.
- To assist in the additional cost students may face as they enter college (e.g., books, materials, etc.).
- To expand the scholarships so that we can continue to award a minimum of seven (7) scholarships or more each year.

## Award

The Scholarship will be awarded annually on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December to deserving residents. A total of \$21,000 will be made in scholarships during the Program's Inaugural Year. Per the seven (7) students, \$3,000 will be awarded in scholarships. In subsequent years we hope to expand the scholarship so that each year we can continue to award a minimum of seven (7) scholarships or more.

## Eligibility

To qualify, students must meet the following criteria:

- U.S. Citizen or legal resident alien, and a current resident of the Tampa Housing Authority Public Housing/RAD or Assisted Housing Program.
- Complete the EFFORTS Scholarship Application Form.
- Be a high school senior or undergraduate freshman enrolled in the semester following the scholarship award.
- Possess a 3.3 GPA or higher.
- 500 hours of community service.
- Submit a personally written 750-word essay expressing the value and importance of stable housing.
- Produce one (1) or more letters from a community leader detailing the student's community involvement.

## Instructions

The complete application package must include the following:

- Signed Release Form
- Completed Biographical Questionnaire
- Current Resume
- One (1) or more letters from a community leader detailing your community involvement
- Personally written 750-word essay expressing the value and importance of stable housing
- Official transcript from High School
- Signed and dated application

All documents must be submitted in one (1) application package. All application documents must be originals, with original signatures, seals, and/or stamps. Application documents containing photocopied signatures and transcripts will not be considered for the THA EFFORTS Scholarship Program.
